FINDINGS OF FACT,  
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND  
ORDER FOR JUDGMENT.

The above entitled action being regularly on the general term calendar of the above named Court came on for hearing before the undersigned, one of the Judges of said Court, without a Jury, on Thursday, the 5th day of November, A. D. 1931. Plaintiff appeared in person and by her Attorney, Norval T. Seland, Esq., there being no appearance by or on behalf of the defendant. The Court having heard the evidence adduced at said trial and being fully advised in the premises, makes the following:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That defendant and plaintiff are husband and wife and were married to each on the 28th day of August, 1926, in the City of Robbinsdale, County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota.
2. That plaintiff's true name is Myrtle Telnora Neisinger and that she is twenty-three (23) years of age; that defendant's true name is Ray Alvin Neisinger and that he is twenty-six (26) years of age.
3. That plaintiff is a resident of Minneapolis, County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota, and that she resided therein continuously for more than one year immediately preceding the filing of the complaint herein.
4. That there is living issue of said marriage, one child, William Ray Neisinger, born on the 17th day of September, 1927.

5. That on or about the 9th day of October, 1929, defendant wilfully deserted plaintiff and has ever since, and for more than one year next preceding the filing of the complaint herein, uninterruptedly continued said desertion.

AS CONCLUSIONS OF LAW THE COURT FINDS

1. That plaintiff is entitled to an absolute divorce from the defendant.

2. That plaintiff is entitled to the sole care, custody and control of William Ray Weisinger, the minor child of the parties hereto.

3. That the defendant shall pay to plaintiff as and for the care and support of William Ray Weisinger, the minor child of the parties

hereto, the sum of <sup>seven</sup> ~~seven~~ (\$7.00) Dollars on Wednesday of each and every week hereafter until the further Order of the Court herein.

*Payable thru the Probation Office of Hennepin County*  
Let Judgment be entered accordingly.
